

C1 - CANCELLATION OF COURSE POLICY

1 PURPOSE

This policy provides assurance that, if BBI – The Australian Institute of Theological Education (BBI-TAITE) determines that it can no longer offer a course, students currently enrolled in that course will not be disadvantaged.

2 BACKGROUND

BBI-TAITE is committed to quality learning and teaching, as reflected in its educational mission. This policy has been created in order to ensure that students who have enrolled in a course have the opportunity to complete it, including in the event that the Institute decided to cancel the delivery of a course.

3 SCOPE

This policy applies to all students and courses of study at BBI-TAITE.

4 DEFINITIONS

5 POLICY

In the event that BBI-TAITE cancels the delivery of a course, it will be required to ensure that either:

a) Students currently enrolled within the course will be able to complete it within the normal period of candidature through study with BBI-TAITE.

OR

b) Students currently enrolled within the course will be presented with options to transfer to another Higher Education Provider who can facilitate their completion of the course with minimal disruption. It will be BBI-TAITE's responsibility to broker such arrangements with other Higher Education Provider and to communicate these with students.
