

APPLICATION FOR RPL MASTER OF LEADERSHIP AND THEOLOGY



Students who have held a leadership position, as specified in the admission requirements, for two or more years may be eligible for up to 40 credit points in Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). Applicants for RPL must submit a performance portfolio of about four pages, (no shorter, but feel free to extend on this if need be) which outlines your leadership experience and clearly articulates how this relates to the following Course Specific Graduate Outcomes. This can then be combined with a letter from your employer who, having sighted the portfolio can provide written support for what you've described therein. Applications for RPL will be assessed in accordance with the Credit Transfer and Recognition of Prior Learning Policy.
